May 25, 2025

This Sunday, May 25th, is the sixth Sunday of Easter. The Gospel of John reminds us not only of how much we are loved by Jesus and His Father in heaven, but also how intimately we are known by our Redeemer and our Creator. Jesus appeared numerous times to His disciples and followers after His resurrection, bringing elation and relief to the people who loved him. Yet Jesus knew that He would be returning to the Father and that it would be difficult for the people who cared for Him. After grieving His death, they would then grieve His ascension into heaven. Therefore, just like a compassionate parent or leader, Jesus explained what would happen and reassured His followers. I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you. Jesus continued His reassurance by promising His disciples His peace and urging them not to let their hearts be troubled or afraid. All of Jesus' words spoke of His great love for His people and His genuine understanding of their fears and hopes, needs and strengths. He knew His people, just as He knows us.

In the last paragraph of today's Gospel, Jesus reiterated that His people would not be abandoned. You heard me say to you. 'I am going away, and I am coming to you.' These words must have been confusing. What did Jesus mean, He is going away and coming to us? As Jesus explained, He was going to return to the Father, and the Father was going to send the Holy Spirit in Jesus' name, to dwell within the hearts of His followers. Jesus made that promise to us, too. His Holy Spirit dwells within our hearts. His Spirit reminds us of His words. His Spirit fills us with strength and courage, comforts us and brings us His peace. Yet, we are given the choice to accept or reject His Holy Spirit. We have been given free will and we can choose to embrace His Holy Sprit, love Him and follow His word. Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. What a promise, God will come to us! How much Jesus and the Father must love all people! God, our God, has blessed us. . . . Let all the ends of the earth revere him. But what if we choose not to love God and refuse to keep His word? We will not be forsaken. Jesus is always by our side, His Spirit always ready to respond. All we need to do, is open our hearts and listen to His voice. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age. (Matthew 28:20) Jesus' Spirit will wait for us to the end of the age. He loves us.


