From the desk of Father William

The story of Thomas is standard during the Easter season, the time dedicated to remembering the early church. We kick off the post-Resurrection narrative with Thomas because he's the "twin." Whose twin? Ours, most likely. Thomas is like us, ready to believe, but only if you pull out all the stops and give him a dramatic example of why he should. If he can touch Jesus with his bare hands, he'll show you all the faith you want! Much is made of Thomas's doubt;

little is said about Thomas's grief. Like the rest of the disciples, he'd lost his teacher, Lord, and friend in that terrible week. When the others brought him words, he dismissed them impatiently. The only thing that would make his experience real is to see—no, to touch—the wounds of Jesus. Apparitions and affidavits wouldn't do. He had to see the cross in the Christ or it would never be real for him. Perhaps this is why the most profound profession of faith in scripture— "My Lord and my God!"—belongs to Thomas. If the cross does not reveal the mercy of God, nothing can. "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

If you ever are in a "Thomas state of mind"—doubting your faith, doubting God's love, doubting our hope for redemption—consider all the great Christians who have gone before you who have experienced similar doubts: Mother Teresa, Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, Saint Teresa of Avila, Saint John of the Cross, Saint Thomas Aquinas, to name but a few. Doubt isn't the opposite of faith. In one of its forms, doubt is a recurring stage of faith. As we grow, change, and experience setbacks, our certainty may be shaken. Doubt sets in and forces us to review, update, and strengthen our core beliefs. Don't be afraid to confront your doubts today. Dear friends, no one comes to faith in isolation. No one plucks Christianity off the shelf of potential world religions and decides intellectually it's right for them. Christianity is an incarnate religion, all about what happens when God gets flesh and blood and dwells in our midst. People come to the church because they see something they haven't seen outside of it. We all say "My Lord and my God!" because somewhere, in a place we can touch, the glory of God was concretely proven to us.

The readings this week serve to remind their hearers that the Easter season is about both celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus and doing something about it: they are full of messages about call, sending, mission. And in the gospel Jesus sends out his disciples with his Spirit in a ministry of forgiveness. How do you testify to the presence of the risen Christ in your life? How do you love as God wants you to love? How do spread peace and forgiveness in the world around you? Well, it all starts right here... right now when we gather in his name. God's abundant mercy for us is worth reflecting on these days. We live in a world that chooses condemnation over mercy, but that choice is always ours to make. Forgive us, O Lord, for our doubts and fears. Help us to be your witnesses to the ends of the earth. Keep us always in your love. And lead us to your kingdom where you live for ever and ever. Believers are those who are of one mind and body, know Jesus Christ to be the Son of God, and love God by keeping God's commandments.
