From Fr. William's Desk

In today's gospel passage, we see a woman from a non-Jewish part of the territories summoning Jesus to an action. He wasn't counting it as part of his job description. For the most part, the redeemer of ancient prophecy was the savior of Israel. Some passages in Isaiah push that envelope quite a bit, but most good Jews who were

expecting anything from heaven at all were expecting fat a son of David to rescue the nation. Canaanite

territory was so not-Israel it wasn't even funny. Pagans were definitely not on God's radar to most devout Jews.

Jesus isn't mean to this woman. He's honest. He tells her she's not a member of his family, and she accepts that. And then she reminds him of something that every dog-loving, cat-cohabiting, fish-supporting, hamster-spinning, bird-feeding animal lover knows: Not all members of a household are created equal but they still belong as part of the whole and still have basic rights. And Jesus is surprised. Her argument was so convincing, he changed his position and embraced hers. Dynamic faith from human beings is enough to surprise heaven sometimes, it seems. Want to give God something unexpected? Offer bold, extraordinary faith. The lesson for all of us is to seek the path beyond our own prejudice to the point where admiration and compassion rule the day in our interactions with others. Let your prejudices be teachable moments!

Incidents like this one should make any Christian careful about making statements as to who is acceptable to God, or who will be saved! In fact, however, many Christians seem to think they know exactly who will be saved, and some even claim to know how many, as well!! The disciples want to "send her away, for she keeps calling after us." Indeed, there is a terrible irony in disciples sending someone away! Jesus does test her faith but when he sees that it is true, he compliments the woman and grants her request. It seems to me that we can all learn a lesson from this. Faith will show up in unexpected, and sometimes "unacceptable," ways and persons. Shall we send away (indeed even ask Jesus to send away) a faithful person who only wants the same help that we ask for and receive? To all those who feel they are the foreigners or the Gentiles or the Canaanites in today's readings, to all those who come to us that we have ignored or turned away or hurt, know this: I apologize for not being church for you. Help us, challenge us to do better. *All Are Welcome* isn't a motto or a song. It is a goal that we can only reach together.


