SUNDAY August 30, 2020 Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

And Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke him, saying "God forbid it. Lord! This must never happen to you." But he turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan!" You are a stumbling block for me; for you are thinking not as God does, but as humans do."

The stumbling block for me then is how I can think like God and not as a human. So I Google it and according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

"Deep within his conscience man discovers a law which he has not laid upon himself but which he must obey. Its voice, ever calling him to love and to do what is good and to avoid evil, sounds in his heart at the right moment. ... His conscience is man's most secret core and his sanctuary. There he is alone with God whose voice echoes in his depths."

Each morning for the past several weeks I have been walking from Willows Beach to Turkey Head and back. And during this time I have been listening to a podcast called "Turning to the Mystics". As I am listening to the narrator take me through prayer and meditation, I walk in deep thought along the ocean; I feel like I am walking with Jesus.

Thomas Merton's words resonate within me, "My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself and the fact that I think I'm following your will does not mean that I'm actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road though I may know nothing about it. Therefore, I will trust you always. Though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death, I will not fear, for you are ever with me and you will never leave me to face my perils alone."

As disciples of Jesus we need to let Him lead, accepting that he will not lead us away from suffering, pain or difficulty. Instead of seeking our own benefit and gain, we allow every experience – even in moments of distress – to draw us into closer relationship with Jesus who invites us to lay our burdens on his shoulders.

Yahweh, I know you are near.
