# SUNDAY August 9, 2020 Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

It should not be too difficult to identity with the disciples in the boat. The seas are rough, threatening. When we have lived a bit, we have all had experiences of the roof falling in on us, or the dropping out on us. It happens when our confidence in people, or for even that matter God, slowly erodes or gets shaken: when disillusioned or facing hardship or illness or coping with the ramifications of a virus.

It is in moments like this that we may find ourselves in the threatening darkness of night surrounded by powerful waves that threatened to swallow us up. "It is in moments like these that we may, like Peter scream: "Lord, save me!" or "Where are you? Where can you be found?" Or the situation may be so threatening, so overpowering, that we cannot even get these words over our lips anymore. It is in such distressing circumstances that the Gospel story of today summons us to confidence and hope. It tries to convince us of God's gracious presence to us, whatever overcomes us. When the Gospel story has Jesus walking on the water and joining the disciples in the chaos that threatens them, then we have a powerful image that in Jesus, God is present to us.

Jesus walking on the water is a powerful image of knowing we are borne and sustained by God's presence. We can only hope and pray for each other, and for ourselves, that the experience of God's presence may help us make it through the dark night of Coved 19, and in whatever ways the darkness of the night may strike us. When the seas of our minds and hearts are roiling; we reach out; allow ourselves to trust; and are offered a sign of peace.

Being dazed and confused, frightened and in pain is not how Jesus wants us to live. Think of the words of Jesus we repeat each time we gather at Eucharist: "My peace I leave you; my peace I give to you." Remember Christ's peace is yours for the taking. That is the miracle of Christian living. Problems and challenges do not disappear but our fear of them does. Instead of Peter's panic, "Lord, save me!"; our

response can be modeled after Peter's faith, "Lord, command me to come to you." We can remain calm even in the midst of chaos. We can, in fact, walk on water. Believe that, and you will have plenty of peace to offer others.
