Reflections from the Gospel Gals

The Third Sunday of Advent, the pink candle of joy is lit and the waiting, hoping, preparing, which predates us by thousands of years, continues with us today.

Many of those living in the time of John the Baptist were eagerly seeking – the Messiah. John, the Baptizer, the desert dweller, brought the people a message at odds with the times, a message of repentance and love, a message that would 'renew the face of the earth'. So radical and hopeful was his message that people from all stations in life sought him out. He was besieged by all – the dishonest and reviled tax collector; the abhorred, occupier-soldier; citizens ordinary and marginalized, authentic and curious. They came to the dessert, to the wilderness, to the heart of their personal dryness and parched lives, yet lives teeming with riches to be unearthed.

One question asked by all who came to John, echoes through the sand dunes and reverberates in our own times, "What should we do?" John told the people that another, far greater than he, was coming. They needed to prepare the way for this Messiah. He told them to repent, to turn to God, to love one another, to be ready for the one for whom they longed and about whom John said he was not worthy even to untie the string of his sandal.

And today, these many years later, what is our answer to the question "What should we do?" On this Sunday of joy, we should rejoice and be glad because God, the Anointed One, the Redeemer is in our midst. We give thanks because the Messiah has re-established the relationship between Creator God and us, his created, a relationship that is ours to grow. We trust because the Lord forgives our transgressions and takes away "the judgements against us" and assures our salvation. We hope because our Messiah renews us in his love, gives us his spirit and promises to walk with us always. We prepare ourselves to welcome the Messiah and to be faithful imitators of his love, doing good works, taking care of one another, daily giving thanks and praise and living out the Good News that we have received.

In the midst of severe tragedy living the Good News of gratitude may not come easily. At these times simply being in our circumstances and remaining faithful, however tentative we may think it to be, is ultimate thanks and praise. Remember when Jesus hung on the cross wracked by pain and dying, he cried out, "My God. My God. Why have you forsaken me?" These words neither betrayed Jesus' faith in his father nor did they diminish his thanks and praise. Much earlier that day Jesus had asked his father to change what he knew lay ahead of him. Yet, he embraced his father's plan for our salvation. He knew that his father walked the road to Calvary with him, that his father would never leave him, that his father would send community to support him on this dreadful journey – the women of Jerusalem, Simon of Cyrene to help him carry his unbearable load. His father gave him the strength to endure to the glory of resurrection. Jesus is with us in the exact same way in everything, even our times of greatest struggle. His life in us sustains us, his union with us in our moments of suffering continue unbroken and he gives us the strength to endure to our resurrection.

Listen to our heart; the babe of Bethlehem is calling our name and speaks to us, expect it; be ready! Trudy Holden
