SUNDAY December 23rd, 2018 Fourth Sunday in Advent

Reflections from the Gospel Gals

Blessed is the fruit of your womb."

The fourth Advent candle is lit today and it represents 'Love'. How appropriate is that when we ponder the words of Elizabeth as she greets Mary and, filled with the Holy Spirit recognizes and announces the Messiah, present in the womb of Mary.

What about us? Do we recognize, like Elizabeth, the true *blessedness* of this child? Jesus: Second person of the Trinity, omnipotent, omnipresent, who always was and always will be - that is who was present in the womb of his mother, Mary. Sent by his Father, placed into time and space, he became man in the form of an infant child. Dependant, vulnerable, he began his human journey, a journey of love, a journey of sacrifice and reconciliation. Advent is the sacred time of year laid aside for us to ponder and embrace this wondrous mystery: all-powerful God become helpless infant, sent to save us.

Even as Elizabeth's words are recorded in today's Gospel, John the Baptist present in his mother's womb makes his first announcement of the presence of Jesus as he leaps for joy! The Saviour is among us! In fact, all of the proclamations and readings we find throughout the Mass today announce the Good News of Jesus' coming and are linked with his saving mission. There is such joy and hope! "Let the earth be opened and bring forth a Saviour." "He shall be great to the ends of the earth; and he shall be peace." "Restore us, O God; let your face shine, that we may be saved." "See God, I have come to do your will, O God.... and it is by God's will that we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all." "His name will be called Emmanuel."

We rejoice today in the faithfulness of our loving Father to fulfill his promise to send a Saviour. The cast of characters in the genealogical line from Abraham to Jesus is not composed of Saints - rather, a myriad of sinners. Jesus is conceived by an unwed mother, born in a manger, dependant on the mercy of strangers and quickly becomes a refugee. We would expect none of this of a God and Saviour. But we have a Creator of surprises whose thoughts are not our thoughts and whose ways are not our ways.

Rejoice in the mercy He pours out. Rejoice that you, too, are His child. Rejoice in Mary's fiat.

We have come full circle with our Advent wreath. Have we truly experienced the hope, peace, joy and love we have been invited to this Season? Yes, or no, there is still time to ponder and embrace the Light, Jesus, the Saviour sent by the Father. Two more sleeps until we will light the fifth, centre candle. Make Christ the centre of our life.
