

What gifts do we bring to the Christ child?

- Let us bring the gift of desire to be one with all God's people the outsider, the stranger, the foreigner like the wise men who came from the east, like those fleeing war, oppression, and hatred. How would we want to be received, treated, and accepted?
- Let us bring the gift of prayer as we open ourselves up to God, deepening our relationship and fine-tuning our hearts to hear God's voice in the silence and the chaos.
- Let us offer the gift of humility, humbly surrendering ourselves completely into God's loving care.
- By letting go of our judgment and seeing the goodness of others, let us offer the gift of charity.
- The gifts of courage, trust, and confidence in God allows our fears and sense of control to melt away as we step out of our comfort zone and say 'yes' to God's plan. The wise men trusted in the star and followed their intuition; Herod felt threatened and out of control and reacted in fear of the unknown.
- Become the gift placed on the altar, transformed by the Star of Bethlehem where God loves us into being, gifts us with the Holy Spirit, and sends us out as God's gift in the world.

We are called to bear witness to Christ's light and to be that light in the world. Will we let the light of Christ transform and enrich our lives? There will be times of darkness, suffering, and pain; times when we are deaf to God's voice and choose to ignore God's light; when we fear, fail, sin, and despair. AND *God-with-us* continues to invite us into the light, continues to fashion us to be children of the light, continues to free us from bondage, and promises to be with us always. We have the choice to live in the grace of God, in the mercy of forgiveness, in the love of the Creator who calls us Beloved, in the light of the Star that dissipates all of our darkness! Trust, hope, and believe.

Each of us has our own personal star guiding us – the star of prayer, love, friendship, support...the star has a different name at different times. Be grateful for your star – and be grateful that you have been a star for others.
