

The Kingdom of God is all around us and within us...do we see it? Or are we like the little fish at the bottom of the ocean who asks his mother where the water is? Like that little fish, I often fail to see what's right in front of me; so wrapped up in my worries and fears, I miss God at work in the present moment. In today's Gospel Jesus tells us that his Kingdom is our greatest treasure, the finest pearl, whether we stumble upon it like the worker in the field or we seek it like the merchant, finding Jesus will transform our heart and our lives.

So, how do we stumble into God's Kingdom in our day-to-day? Is it when we hear the soft whisper of the Holy Spirit asking us to look, and we see the miracle of a hummingbird hovering over a red geranium, and for a few moments, time seems to stop as we witness this gift of God's creation? Or when we hold a little grandchild in our arms, getting lost in their gaze of pure love, the kind that pierces the heart and touches the soul...Jesus' kind of love; and we forget to breathe, suspended in the wonder and beauty of God. In our stumble, we bump smack into Jesus, our King; it's his love that allows us to see our world through his eyes, having glimpsed in that brief moment the beauty, joy and peace of his Kingdom we long for more, turning us into seekers of Jesus.

But it's Jesus who seeks us first; he's our shepherd and his call to follow him is a gentle call. A call I heard more clearly during the quiet months of self isolation; when the whole world was hushed and all of a sudden there was more time to be still, more time to pray. St. Teresa of Avila once said that we hear a lot about what people do in prayer, but we don't often hear about what God achieves in us in prayer. What is achieved is the dialogue of hearts between us and Jesus...he opens our eyes and ears to his presence in our lives. We seek and find Jesus in our love of family, in the acts of mercy by the neighbor next door, in the kind words spoken by the stranger...a clear sign, Jesus, our King, is at work in his Kingdom. A Kingdom we help to build by taking the love and faith we have in Jesus and sharing it with the world.

The Kingdom of God is here, but like the oceans that are continuously fed by fresh water from the rivers and streams, God's Kingdom continues to come. Jesus knows our struggles, he is beside us when we stumble, when we seek and especially when we are so lost we need to be carried back to Him by those who love us. Our treasure is the faith we have in Jesus, knowing he will never ever give up on us, we are ALL children of God and he will lead us back to his Father, all he asks is that we follow.
