## SUNDAY July 5, 2020 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Oh good and gracious God, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, You continually rebuild, re-store, and re-member us in right relationship with You. Your kingdom is without end as You lavishly pour out your indwelling Spirit to all. We are born into the freedom of the Holy Spirit, constantly being filled with nudges, kisses, wisdom, and guidance. Are we aware of the movement of the Spirit working in our lives? Do we seek counsel with the Spirit of God to live according to God's will? Let us ask the Spirit for the grace to possess a humble heart.

Those who possess humility, like the little ones, totally depend on God and trust in God's Word. Humility opens the door to true knowledge of God. Like Jesus, our self-emptying creates sacred space for God's greater glory to be revealed. We are called to surrender to God in humble obedience.

Jesus invites us to 'come and rest', to let go of our burdens, to surrender for He is gentle and humble in heart. Like oxen who are yoked and work in the field, Jesus is asking us to be 'yoked' with Him to work in God's kingdom. A yoke itself seems like a burden, an instrument of bondage and torture, yet precise measurements are taken of each animal to build a comfortable, specific, well-fitted yoke. The yoke makes plowing easier by distributing the load more evenly and allowing for better coordination between the oxen.

Jesus' yoke is one of peace, forgiveness, mercy, and love offered freely, humbly, and designed specifically for us. Jesus walks with each one of us, ever present in all our life experiences, lightening our load, carrying our load, loving us and deepening our relationship. What stands in our way of living an intimate relationship with God? Is it a yoke of independence, one filled with pride, anger, worry, or judgment? Which yoke do we want to carry through life...one that separates and causes pain or one that is light, easy, and shares the load?

The Spirit of Truth says, 'I relieve your shoulders of the burden; your spirit is free to create.' Trust, believe, and lean into the peace only God can give.

#### **UPCOMING FUNERAL SERVICES**


