This week, we present the face of lesus that's easy to love. Jesus offers us rest from our labor, relief from our burdens. He'll take our yoke and replace it with his own, which is light and easy to carry. This Jesus is meek and humble, not strict or demanding..

Here he speaks to us in everyday language! Abruptly Jesus broke into prayer: "Thank you, Father,

Lord of heaven and earth. You've concealed your ways from sophisticates and knowit-alls, but spelled them out clearly to ordinary people. Yes, Father, that's the way you like to work." Jesus resumed talking to the people, but now tenderly. "The Father has given me all these things to do and say." This is a unique Father-Son operation, coming out of Father and Son intimacies and knowledge. Jesus speaks to you today: "Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with me and work with me-watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly".

The same lesus who offers us rest has cosmic expectations of those who answer the call: "Come to me." Ask yourself the following: Do you get sufficient physical rest? That includes finding the right balance of exercise and sleep, invigorating activity as well as restful, rejuvenating times. Do you enjoy enough emotional rest? Do you plan enough down time, as well as time with family, friends, and colleagues who let you relax? How about spiritual rest? Are you spiritually antsy...suffering from a kind of spiritual insomnia? Or are you able to "rest in God"? In your prayer life, do you turn to God for consolation and strength? Are you able to quiet down the 10,000 voices inside and hear the "still small voice" of God? We're all worthy, by God's grace, of the peace and happiness of rest. We just have to breathe in God's love to experience it! Come to me..... He speaks to you... In this minute.
