Archbishop Luiguio Bonazzi on our retreat last week gave us a wonderful definition of the Trinity. He said, the first mystery of our faith is not a theoretical one but a personal one. God is more than an idea, he said. God is the reality of the reality. He told us that in the Trinity we learn what the word love means. Love giving is the father; love received is the Son and love communion is the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is a family in a relationship of love. God as divine family is

The Trinity is, after all, not a triangle of Persons distinctly defined. Nor is it a series of masks God wears as circumstances warrant. The first idea leaves you with a heretical set of three Gods. The second qualifies you as a Unitarian. I've been guilty of both errors along the way, as I suspect most of us are. Preserving the peculiar arithmetic of Trinity, in which Three-Equals-One and One is somehow known in Three, is a theological dance that trips up the many.

Many scripture texts support the revelation of divine love. That is why dear friends the feast of Holy Trinity is for us Christians the feast of God. It is complex but in a way so simple! There is nothing more mysterious, nothing more profound. God is at the same time, many and one. The membership card to this privileged group is faith. Jesus never had the privilege of writing a paper on the Trinity and, nor did he define the Trinity for us. Instead, he taught us in parables that can be hard to understand. He showed us examples designed to influence our world. He offered us encounters so we might see with new eyes.

9:00am The theological textbook Jesus left us was his life— and it can sometimes be difficult to read. But along with his life, his stories, his miracles, his death and resurrection, Jesus left us each other. On the very night he was betrayed, he taught us how to wash each other's feet and asked us to gather as one body and break bread together. Even as he was dying upon the cross, he commended us to each other's care. The Trinity is the Christian way of talking about God as a family in love. The feast is the occasion for us to pray for the grace (for the Church and for us as individuals) of a "Trinitarian spirituality".

Let us celebrate the family of love,


SOUTH SUDAN FAMINE RELIEF SPECIAL COLLECTION

Deadline: July 1, 2017




