
Mission Statement: Twinning with St. Patrick's Parish

# SUNDAY June 16, 2019 The Solemnity Of The Most Holy Trinity

Trinitarian theology is bewildering for many. The language is about as sophisticated and complex as it can get. But they all convince me of the impossibility of doing God justice by trying to talk about God. We simply ask too much of language. Our words will always pale beside the reality. The language of the Trinity is the language of love and it is rooted in Jesus.

Jesus never defined the Trinity for us. He didn't leave us a theological roadmap or publish a textbook. He didn't distribute recipes, diagrams, drawings, or charts. Instead, he taught us in parables that can be hard to understand. He showed us examples designed to influence our



world. He offered us encounters so we might see with new eyes. The whann@rcdvictoria.org

theological textbook Jesus left us was his life— and it can sometimes be difficult to read. But along with his life, his stories, his miracles, his death and resurrection, Jesus left us each other. We might think of the Trinity as the God to whom we relate as parent, as Son, daughter, brother, and sister, and as an abiding, loving Spirit. The Trinity is one way of saying that God is not alone. God, to be person, must live in relationship. If God is love, then God must be self-giving, overflowing into creativity. To be defined as love means that there must be some relationship to another. That is what it is all about.

When we gather as a community of faith to celebrate and worship, we are living this mystery. God's artistry is the key to today's readings. A God so far above us that he remains forever in a "Cloud of Unknowing" and yet who is, as St Augustine said, closer to us than our very breathing. How wonderful to know that we have a God like this! Friedrich Nietzsche the pessimistic nihilist once said: "I can only believe in a dancing God." As Sebastian Moore retorts: "No one ever told him about the Trinity, in which the persons only are in each other, so that all is movement, recalling another line of T.S. Eliot, 'and there is only the dance.' That is the dance of the Holy Spirit. That is the love God who so loves this world (John's Gospel today) that he comes to dance himself.

So, gnaw on theology and doctrine all you want today, but save room for the dance. Dance a bit today in the beauty and music of a limitless love that could never just be one, but must be at least three, and at most, an invitation to a whole universe to hum and jig with delight. This is what we are celebrating in our feast of the Trinity. This is why we are giving praise and thanks to God in this Eucharist. Because God is not alone and because we are not alone and never will be. Accept the Trinity as truth ...as the language and the dance of love. Dostoevsky warned what happens to those who lose contact with the truth: They "lose all respect for themselves and for others. And having no respect, they cease to love." Choose respect, choose love, and everyone begins to matter.
