

## **Reflections from the Gospel Gals**

Mark gives us Christ's teaching of the Kingdom of God. The Parable of the Mustard Seed was given to the disciples behind closed doors by Christ. He describes the mustard seed as the smallest seed on earth. Though the seed appears small, even insignificant, it possesses great potential. Now he has their attention. The mustard seed is tiny and this dot { .} gives the approximate size. The farmer plants the seed not knowing how it will grow. Then with time, sun and rain, the seed sprouts. Though the plant is a herb and usually a shrub, there are massive mustard trees too. What a wonderful illustration to picture the seed quickly growing into a tree, as we open our hearts to our growing seed of Faith and Trust in God. My friend explains that ... as with the seed growth, spiritual maturity doesn't happen overnight. Understanding the kingdom requires patience and timing. Ah, God is there to grow the tree without any intervention from us. And he is there to provide for us. As Christ was speaking to the disciples he explains the growing of the Kingdom of God. They are but a handful, the smallest of beginnings going out into our world. As we now see the kingdom has spread over the world in massive numbers. How do we open our hearts, our minds, and our souls to understand the kingdom? The start is like the parable.

Trust God to plant and grow our seed of faith and provide for us on our journey. Empowered by God's Presence and unconditional Love we can live as St. Teresa of Avila expressed it, "Christ has no body now on earth but yours, no hands but yours, no feet but yours." Yours are the eyes through which Christ's compassion is to look out to the world. Yours are the feet with which Christ is to go about doing good. Yours are the hands with which Christ is to bless all people.
