SUNDAY June 2, 2019 The Ascension of the Lord

Easter was over several weeks ago, right? Not really, because the story goes on. The post-Resurrection Jesus appeared to his disciples. He ate with them. And he spent 40 days preparing them to continue his mission. Today we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension, recalling the day Jesus ascended from this human life to enter divine glory and be "seated at God's right hand." Ascension brings to a remarkable close the Easter events that we call the "Pascal Mystery": the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus. Yet this really is not an end either. After the Ascension, the disciples returned to Jerusalem with joy, ready and eager for what was to come. Allow me to unpack this insight.

Today's celebration is the ritual marker of the shift in the way the Disciples of Christ have experienced his risen presence. But the readings look resolutely forward, not back as if to a golden age now lost. In Acts, the disciples are prodded by angelic visitors to get to work: "Why do you stand looking up toward heaven?" The ascension of Jesus into heaven has nothing to do with his departure from our world. Jesus has not left our inhuman world in search of a better world among the stars. He has not turned his back on us. On the contrary, his ascension means that he is more than ever powerfully present and active among us to accomplish the task for which he was sent and for which now he enlists us as his disciples: the bringing about of God's Kingdom of love, justice and peace for our world. In that light, celebrating the ascension of Jesus has nothing to do with saying goodbye to Jesus. Rather, it is our being empowered by him, and our accepting the task and challenge to change our world in his power, so that it becomes indeed God's kind of world.

Concretely, that means that we place ourselves in his Spirit on the side of the vulnerable and marginalized in our society, and that we promote human life everywhere. Whatever makes life more human becomes our task. In short, from our witness in the word, but above all in deeds it must become evident that Jesus has not been eliminated from our world but is in fact is very much active in it. From now on, it is by means of our lives, by means of our discipleship that we give concrete evidence of the fact that Jesus is not absent from our world, but still very much present in our world. That is a good message to proclaim and live on this World Communication Sunday.

Let's roll up our sleeves and carry on their ministry.

THE SAINT OF HOPE WILL VISIT THE DIOCESE

From Saturday, October 19 to Sunday, October 27, two first-class and precious relics of the Portuguese-born saint, Saint Anthony of Padua, will tour major regions of the diocese from Port Hardy to Victoria. Father Mario Conte will bring the holy relics from the saint's Basilica in Padua, Italy. The two exquisite reliquaries, one of which contains layers of skin of the saint's cheek and the other a fragment of his floating rib, were venerated by Saint Mother Teresa, Saint John Paul II and Servant of God, Sister Lucia of Fatima. Tom Muscatello will accompany Friar Mario during the Autumn North American Tour.

Pope Francis shares "The saints give us a message. They tell us: be faithful to the Lord, because the Lord does not disappoint! He does not disappoint ever, and he is a good friend always at our side." According to Friar Mario Conte, the Executive Editor of the Messenger of St Anthony, a magazine written, published and printed by the Franciscan Friars in Padua for the English-speaking world, "There is nothing superstitious about relics. The real meaning of a relic is love – they are a link of love between the person who venerates and the saint. In recognizing that only God performs miracles, it is through the communion of saints that we are brought closer to Our Lord." Stay tuned for more details in early September.
