SUNDAY June 30, 2019 Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Follow me." Today's reading is placed in Luke's Gospel at the end of Jesus' ministry in Galilee and at the beginning of his journey to Jerusalem. 'Follow me'. The responses Jesus receives to this invitation imply a 'yes', but with a 'but not right now' approach.

Jesus was headed to his cross and the invitation was to go along with him. Consider what it would truly mean to accompany a friend on the kind of journey we know Jesus was on. Would we excuse our way out of it? Tell him 'we've got other things to do right now, maybe later'? Very few chose to stay with Jesus. Those who did were connected to him heart and soul - his mother, Mary Magdalene and John for three. They were steadfast and so deeply in love with Jesus that they would not have chosen otherwise.

Jesus is still hoping for and inviting us to accompaniment. In our culture today it seems that there is little deep, abiding relationship with our God. In his book, *The Shattered Lantern: Rediscovering a Felt Presence of God*, Ronald Rolheiser suggests the reasons why: we have become a 'me' society; we've become so practical and busy as to have lost our sense of mystery and sacredness; and we live our lives so restlessly we cannot focus.

How can we re-enter the journey and follow Jesus by having him touch our lives? While Jesus is present to us in the Eucharist in physical form, he is always present spiritually. The question is, are we present to him? Even by participating in those activities that we know have meaning in a Christian sense we may still lack the profoundly deep relationship that is available to us. That kind of relationship requires mindfulness, choosing to acknowledge the presence of Jesus in our thoughts, actions and interactions.

In the past week I have experienced an intersection of events that could not be ignored. One of the Gospel Gals quoted Karl Rahner on the topic of mystics; coincidentally the same quote about mystics was in the bulletin; and I was involved in an unexpected conversation about the need to deepen our relationship with God. All of this was on the backdrop of reading Rolheiser's book — one I only happened to pick up from the free book table a couple of weeks ago. The quote by Karl Rahner, Jesuit Priest: "In the days ahead, you will either be a mystic (one who has experienced God for real) or nothing at all." That is a bold statement. The term 'mystic' conjures an image of isolation, asceticism and holiness. I immediately think 'desert father', not me. But the fact is we are all capable of experiencing God 'for real'. Rolheiser discusses the teachings of St. John of the Cross in depth and mentions other disciplines such as Ignatian Spirituality, meant to focus us on Jesus, make us more prayerful and contemplative and get us into profound relationship with our God. If I choose to begin a contemplative practise, have the discipline to follow through, take time and focus I know I could improve my relationship with God. How about you? It would help us progress on the journey Jesus invites us to.

As a Resurrection people our journey with Jesus, grounded in a heart-and-soul relationship, will take us to the depth of our selves and others, in Him. Relationship. Love. "Follow me" will take on a whole new meaning. Will we do it now, or say 'maybe later'.
