SUNDAY - June 5th, 2022 **Pentecost Sunday**

Pentecost, 50 days after Jesus' death and resurrection, the day the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles, empowering them, gifting them, and filling them with God's grace. The Spirit of God came in an unexpected way – as a violent wind and fire – an intense force to be reckoned with! Both images illustrate a dramatic cleansing, purification, and transformation from former ways to a newness, a strength, a confidence, a knowing that we are one dynamism. We are called to leave our pride, our prejudices, and our hostilities on the cross as we resurrect into the one body of Christ, embolded by the enveloping power of the Spirit.

The Spirit loosens our tongues and various languages flow forth enabling us to understand one another – unexpected! Brian McLaren says, "The Spirit of God is multiligual. The Spirit isn't restriced to one elite language or one superior culture. Instead, the Spirit speaks to everyone everywhere in his or her native tongue, unity and diversity in harmony." The energizing strength of the Spirit brings us together. When we share with others how God is working in our lives, the Spirit gives us the right words. When fear stops us from reaching out to others that are different from us, the Spirit softens our hearts so we can reach out in love. When relationships are broken and we don't know how to reconcile, the Spirit fills us with mercy and humility. The indwelling Spirit answers our prayers, we just need to ask and place our trust in God's promises.

God freely gifts us with a variety of graces and asks us to be partners in creating a better way for all – unexpected! Each of us is called to work together to serve the common good. These gifts engender lovingkindness, mercy, and generosity, and with these gifts we praise God, build up the holy body of Christ, and activate the power of love for all. McLaren states we are called to the way of love, not fear; openness, not prejudice; service, not supremacy; equality, not inferiority; reconciliation, not resentment; connection not isolation; the spirit of hospitality, not hostility. The way of God, the way of love is all inclusive as we drink from the same Spirit, the one cup of Christ.

Jesus comes to us, offers us peace, and calls us forth to serve even though the doors of our hearts are locked in fear – unexpected! Jesus knows our worries and gently enfolds us in unconditional love, forgiveness, and wholeness of life. Intimately, Jesus *breathed* the Holy Spirit into us, filling us with light and empowering us to go forth and be Good News. Let the Spirit in! Allow the passion and promise of 'God with us' dwell within and flow out to all those we encounter!

Today we celebrate Pentecost when the Spirit was given to the disciples by Christ. It is the birth of the Church, the day when the fearful and tentative apostles were transformed into bold preachers of Jesus

and his resurrection. That same Spirit is alive and active in the Church today, transforming it - and us - to stand strong in the world as the body of Christ, breathing the gift of peace and love to all. Expect the unexpected!
