From the desk of Father William

We are well into Lent. You could call it our journey through the desert, our journey to Easter, the light and the new life. We Christians go this path like everyone else, like ordinary people; that is to say like men and women who are marked by everything that happens in our world. As Christians, we are not protected from the disillusionment of life. It is moments like these that we can hear ourselves say: "where is our God? Does he really care?" Perhaps we would not dare to say it, but don't we often think:" what is the use of being Christian in

a world where you must fend for yourself, where you should not get your expectations too high, because you are bound to get hurt and disillusioned?"

Jesus himself appears on our path today, well into Lent, closer to Easter. And he points us to the cross on which he will be lifted up. What are we saying when we wear a cross or place one in our homes? What are we saying to ourselves when we sign ourselves with the cross? Is it not time that we rediscover the true meaning of these gestures; that we allow ourselves to be struck by the truth that the cross holds for us, namely that our life stories- which for all of us are a composite of light and darkness- are mixed up with a God who cares for us, a God who is faithful to us? I am in no way suggesting that the cross will serve as a mascot to protect us from the ugly side of life.

If the cross is a sign of anything at all, then it is a sign of the certainty that a faithful God stands by us and is prepared to slug it out with us. We have him to cling to, and if we look attentively at him, we see that his hands and heart are open to us. The cross signifies for us that God's entire existence is one of being given for us. With that kind of God in our lives, we will not have to go under. The entire purpose of Jesus coming into the world was that he might give it life. The cross is the ultimate example of God's love for the world.

Dear friends, at bottom, faith is simply a turning to the God who has already shown love for us. This conversion— "turning around"—can give us the eyes to see through difficulties and relieve us of the burden to have to work so hard to earn God's favor. How does God show loving kindness to me? How do I show loving kindness to others, especially when others are difficult to love? Hermann Hesse said it best...we know quite well, deep within us, that there is only ... a single power, a single salvation ... and that is called loving.
