SUNDAY - March 5th, 2023 The Second Sunday of Lent

Our Lenten journey is a holy call from God to TRUST. Trust in the promises of God; trust in the crucified Christ; trust in the voice of God who proclaims Jesus as Beloved Son and Saviour of the world. We are called to fast from self-reliance and trust in God.

God tells Abram to leave his homeland, his extended family and friends, all he knows and trusts to be true, good, safe and secure and go to an unknown land! In those days, the world was very tribal, yet God was asking Abram to leave his clan, his support systems, and take a leap of faith. Was it reckless and uncomfortable? You bet!

God promises Abram that he will be a great nation, and despite the odds, Abram trusts. God continues to bestow blessings on Abram, and the power of God's blessings reverberates out so Abram will be a blessing to others, and those who bless Abram will be blessed, and in Abram, all families of the earth shall be blessed. And it is through these blessings that God provides layers of protection and security for Abram's journey forward.

God specifically blesses each one of us with life, with gifts given through God's grace so we can say 'yes' to God's call to 'go.' God's blessing is specific enough to address our specific circumstances and universal enough to extend to all peoples of the earth.

God calls Abram to cut off ties to his past and his future. How does he respond? In faithful obedience and complete trust in God's promises. Let us pray for the grace to respond like Abram!

If Abram isn't your cup of tea, check out Paul who is in prison for Christ! Paul gladly suffers for the truth; he knows the true power of God, the power of salvation that saves souls and transforms lives. Paul trusts that the power of God is always present, but it is not always there to *remove* the difficulty. Sometimes it is there to see us *through* the difficulty.

Paul is ready to die for Christ...are we? He is Christ-focused, courageous, relies completely on the indwelling Spirit, and challenges us to trust in the crucified Christ. Like Paul, we are called to fulfill our holy calling, this God given grace to live as the Body of Christ, a body where we love one another and serve one another in the world.

If these two humans don't convince us to trust, will God? The transfiguration calls us to trust in Christ the Saviour. God very clearly says, "This is **my Son**, the **Beloved**; with him I am **well pleased**; **listen** to him!" God sets Jesus above the Law (Moses) and the Prophets (Elijah) as *the* Messiah. God reiterates what was said at Jesus' baptism, but this time, the disciples hear God's voice. Can you imagine the holy awe felt by the disciples?!

We also hear the gentle voice of Jesus telling us to "Get up and do not be afraid." Jesus is calling us to a new life, a life filled with His love, peace, grace, and compassion that can *transfigure* us each and every day. This Lent, take the time to sit and listen to God's voice, pray for a listening heart, a heart full of love for God, a heart that is open to transformation. Let us pray that our journey through Lent be a metamorphosis, where we are transformed into a butterfly.
