SUNDAY May 19, 2019 Fifth Sunday of Easter

The invitation to love is ever ancient and ever new. Jesus gives us one commandment: Love one another. There it is. There is no need for multiple tabs and reference books. No need for strategy sessions. Bishop Gary made the message so profound for the children at Saint Patrick's last week who received their First Communion and First Conformation ...Jesus loves them. This gift of Jesus' life given in bread and wine is always the same. It's always the same love, the same gift, the same Jesus who gives himself to us in unconditional love.

That is why today's Gospel is such a profound passage! It is part of the great farewell speech at the Last Supper. It gets down to basics. This very short passage from John comes from Jesus' discourse at the Last Supper. We might call it potluck talk or "table talk." Jesus does three things: he gives a command, promises an example, and offers a blueprint by which faithful disciples will be judged. Judas has left the table, and Jesus is sharing the sad message that he will not be with them much longer. He has washed the feet of the disciples and told them that they must follow this example of love. Now he repeats the message: "You must love one another."

To love one another is not as natural as it is sometimes made out to be. Authentic love, at least when we live it above a sentimental feeling, exacts a price. It includes risk, pain, sweat, and tears. **In short, in the Gospel love is always cross-shaped.** Every human creature is drawn to give oneself in love, to surrender to the attraction of love. This is the rhythm of creation, a pull as fundamental as the ebb and flow of tides pulled by the moon. As Dante said, "We are swept along in life in a dance of love."

How do you love? How do you experience love? And what do you and I do to reflect Christ's commandment "to love one another"? Mother Teresa said it best: "Be kind and merciful. Let no one ever come to you without coming away better and happier. Be the living expression of God's kindness: kindness in your face, kindness in your eyes, kindness in your smile, kindness in your warm greeting."

Since Easter and beyond to the Ascension and Pentecost, our Mass Readings include those taken from the ACTS (of the Apostles). Our parish library details those very early days of the Apostles and the early church community life. The Apostles were endowed and continued with Christ's gift of healing. - <u>In the Steps of St Paul</u> by H V Morton. This remarkable travelogue of the author in 1935-36 (well before statehood of Israel recognized) tracing St Paul's journeys through Palestine, Israel, Syria, Turkey, Greece and Rome


