SUNDAY - May 28th 2023 Pentecost Sunday

Today, May 28th, is Pentecost Sunday, the great feast that celebrates the beginning of the church's mission to all people of the earth and the fulfillment of a promise Jesus made to his disciples. During the past weeks the scriptures have been filled with assurances that even though Jesus would return to the Father he would remain with us in spirit. The Father will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. (John 14) I will not leave you orphaned; I am coming to you. (John 14) And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age. (Matthew 28)

Looking at the extraordinary story of God and humanity, it becomes clear that the event of Pentecost is a significant revelation of God's faithful and merciful love for each of us. Pentecost and two other momentous events form the pillars of this story. First, in the beginning, God created the universe and humanity out of love. He gave us life and affirmed that it was good. Secondly, God sent his son Jesus to show us the way of mercy and love. Jesus redeemed humanity by dying on the cross, demonstrating how deeply God cares for us. Thirdly, after Jesus' ascension, God sent His Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with courage and truth; to help us follow the way of love that Jesus had taught us, and for which God had created us. This extraordinary story of God and humanity is about love, a deep and all-embracing love that we have difficulty understanding and believing. We are so blessed to live in this era, to know this story of love, to realize that God does not leave us *orphaned*; is with us *until the end of the age*.

The story of Pentecost is exciting and memorable; tongues of fire descending, different languages being spoken and heard, crowds of people gathering and the apostles of Jesus on fire for God. The fruits of the Holy Spirit are revealed! And those fruits are for each one of us. We all carry the spirit individually and in community. God inspires each one of us with insight, peace, courage, compassion, with love. [Jesus] breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." If there ever was any question about God's love for all, the happening of Pentecost confirms beyond a shadow of a doubt that God loves all people, Greeks and Jews, women and men, slaves and free, rich and poor. The implications of Pentecost are immeasurable! For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body.

A few weeks ago, Father William suggested that God needs us to bring compassion and justice to the world; that despite being sinners we are a chosen and holy people. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we are the ones who bring the good news to the world. With the awareness that we are part of one body, we are the ones who share the extraordinary story of God's love and mercy. Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you. Tanya Taft
